

## JUNIOR SHOWMAN REQUIREMENTS AND FUNDING PROCEDURES

- Must be a paid PJSA Member as of 3-31 of the current year
- Must attend at least 2 PJSA meetings per calendar year.  
(A Limit of one conference call is acceptable for being in attendance)
- Must submit a Competition Form for proof of participation to the PSA Board,  
(Available on the PSA Website)
- Animal must be a registered Simmental
- The Max to be paid out by the PSA will be \$2,000,  
with any funds above that to be paid by private donations.
- Incentives available up to the following levels: (1/ level/ year)
  1. County (Any County Fair) - \$25.00
  2. State (Any State Fair) - \$50.00
  3. Regional (Any Jr. Regional Show) - \$100.00
  4. National (Any National Show) - \$200.00  
(Jr National - Louisville, Denver, KC Royal, KILE, Etc.)
- Winner of the PA Farm Show Jr Simmental Show will receive  
The Nat Shoemaker Memorial Chair.
- BONUS:
  1. When a Jr is exhibiting an animal purchased at a PSA sponsored sale  
at any of the above shows, they receive a One-Time payout - \$100.00
  2. A junior who exhibits an animal that is Bred and Owned  
will receive a One-Time payout - \$100.00
